Animal Superhero Masks!

Think about your favorite superhero. What is their main power? Do they fly, are they super strong, can they shoot spider webs from their hands? Animals have superpowers too! Bats fly, ants can lift 50 times their weight, and spiders create intricate webs. Create an animal mask and become the next big superhero!



Use paper, cardboard, or a paper plate for the base of your mask. Cut out eye holes and make a small hole on each side of the mask. Color and cut out ears, nose, and/or whiskers and attach them to the mask with glue or tape. Continue to decorate the mask to make it look like the animal you want to be. Thread string through the holes on the sides and then tie it on your head!

To make wings like these, just grab a blanket and attach the corners to each wrist using hair ties or ribbon. Then attach the two sides of the blanket to your upper arms using more hair ties or ribbon.
