




There are so many things to discover when you are exploring nature in the Spring. Why not try to keep track of all the fun things you find? Use the chart below to keep a tally of how many things you find or hear in a day.

Type of Animal	Tally

Mammals (squirrels, humans, raccoons; finding their tracks counts too)
