2. When your shopping list is ready, access the online ordering system on our website. Members will receive the link to the order form directly via email.
3. On the order form, select your preferred pick up time: May 21 or May 22 at Baltimore Woods.
4. Hit the submit button when you're done, no payment is required up front. You'll receive a copy of your order form immediately.
5. Within 48 hours, you'll receive a confirmation email from us. After reviewing your order, our staff will call to confirm your plant selections and process your payment.
6. Quantities are limited; orders will be filled in sequence received: payment due before pick-up.

| TCH7            | CHERRY      | Jaded                        | <i>organic</i> , green tomato developed by crossing several heirloom varieties. Can be harvested when translucent green; they also become sweeter when they turn more golden     |
| TCH8            | CHERRY      | Green Bee                    | <i>New, organic</i> , a chef favorite for its tangy flavor; firm texture is ideal for grilling and roasting, can be stored for weeks at room temperature or months at 55 degrees |
| TCH9            | CHERRY      | Egg Yolk                     | sweet, prolific, bright yellow cherry  |
| TSP1            | SAUCE/PASTE | Coure Di Bue                 | <i>heirloom</i> , large, oxheart tomato, great for sauce   |
| TSP2            | SAUCE/PASTE | San Marzano                  | <i>heirloom</i> ; considered the best sauce tomato   |

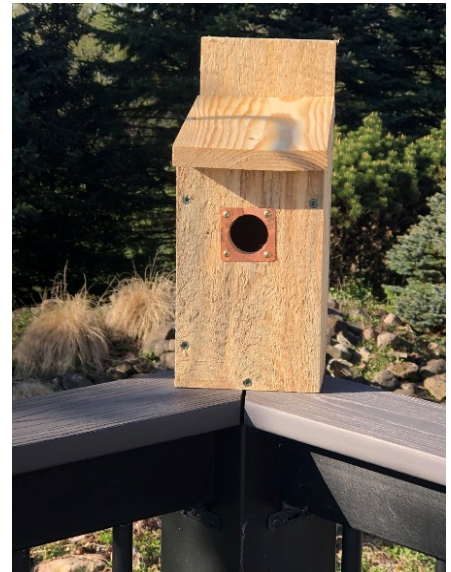
