Baltimore Woods reserves the right to refuse any work that does not meet criteria.

- ☐ You must be a current member of BWNC for the duration of the exhibit.
- ☐ Artwork must be for sale - only one piece per artist will be accepted.
- ☐ Artwork must depict nature of Upstate New York - abstract or representational, 2D or 3D.
- ☐ Artwork must be original - no patterns or kits.
- ☐ 2D artwork must be a combined width and length of 40" **or less** including the frame.
- ☐ Wall pieces must be **wired** for hanging to accommodate our hanging system.
- ☐ Artwork must hang on a wall or stand on a flat surface, i.e. no mobiles.
- ☐ Artwork must have been completed within three years of the exhibit dates.
- ☐ Artwork must be appropriate for a viewing audience of all ages.

Work may not be removed from the exhibit by the artist until the close of the show without consent of the Gallery Coordinator. It is preferred that artwork that is sold remain on display until the close of the exhibit.

Insurance

Artwork is insured up to a maximum of \$10,000. Please note that this is the maximum amount of coverage in totality, not for individual pieces. *Baltimore Woods is not responsible for any work that is not picked up by the end of the day on December 21.*

Sales

- Baltimore Woods Nature Center receives a 30% commission on all work sold in the gallery. For a period of sixty days following the close of the exhibit, if a piece is purchased directly from the artist that is the consequence of having seen it at Baltimore Woods Nature Center, then BWNC is entitled to a 20% commission.
- New York State sales tax of 8% is collected at the time of sale. BWNC will report the sales tax and forward payment to the state.
- Payment from sales to the artist is scheduled to be within 30 days after the close of the exhibit. In the case that the amount of the check is to be \$600 or more, a tax identification number will be required before the check can be issued.
